

# Applied Linguistics 220N

In this class, students need to interview someone who speaks two languages as part of the final project. Some students typically do not have a good device to record video of the interview. More details from my class below.

## Narrative Interview FINAL Project

As your last project in this class, you will complete a narrative interview project in which you will collect, analyze, and present oral histories or other stories from multilinguals. The people you interview may be members of your own family, language learners, or parents of bilingual children. If you do not know of anyone, please see me ASAP. The stories collected may be spoken or written, but will include audio-visual components in addition to text.

### Overview of Assignment

You will write interview questions, record the interview (You may use your phone voice memo or camera app on a smartphone, borrow a video camera from the MIC, go to the One Button Studio to record it, set up and record a Zoom interview, etc.), and then present the interview in a poster session.

### Part One

Set up and do the interview. Interviews should be at least 10 minutes with 10 questions (or more). You need to send me or show me the interview audio or video file.
